Elias Laurin Meyer studied statistics at the University of Vienna, graduating with a bachelor's degree in 2016 and a master's degree in 2018. His master's thesis was awarded "best applied master thesis in applied statistics" by the Austrian Statistical Society and he was admitted to the Class of Excellence at the University of Vienna "for outstanding academic achievement and interpersonal competence". He has been working at the Center for Medical Data Science at the Medical University of Vienna since 2016, where he served as the primary biostatistician in multiple research project with clinicians, publishing ~30 papers with clinicians since. After gaining insight into pharmaceutical statistics during internships at Roche and Novartis, he started working on the IMI EU-PEARL project, which aims to advance the development of integrated research platforms to enable more patient-centric drug development. Within the project, he is co-lead contributor of a deliverable related to software implementation of statistical analysis and simulation procedures and first author of five papers related to the design and simulation of platform trials. Under the supervision of Franz König, he completed his PhD thesis on "Designing exploratory platform trials" at the Medical University of Vienna in 2022 and will soon start a new role as Statistical Scientist at Berry Consultants.
