Deborah Watson-Jones is a medical doctor and clinical epidemiologist and is Professor of Clinical Epidemiology & International Health at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM). She has been based in Tanzania at the Mwanza Intervention Trials Unit since 1995. Her research interests include the evaluation of prophylactic Ebola, COVID-19 and HPV vaccines. She is the coordinator of the EBOVAC1 and EBOVAC3 consortia that are evaluating the Ad26.ZEBOV/ MVA-BN®-Filo prophylactic Ebola vaccine with the aim to bring the vaccine to licensure. She is the LSHTM lead investigator for EBOVAC 1/3 trials in East Africa and Sierra Leone. She is a member of the Africa CDC SAGE committee.
